John has worked from offices in Dundee, London and Glasgow and has coordinated the structural engineering aspects of projects with values up to £25M. He has been a practice principal for over 20 years.

John has over 36 years' experience in the design and supervision of a wide range of projects. He is the Director responsible for the Glasgow office.
